



Riga Stars/Fudzi Cup 2016

Organizer: Fudzi Sports Club & Latvian Karate Federation

Place: Olympic Sports Centre, Grostonas street 6b, Riga, Latvia

Date: 27.03.2016 Beginning at 10.00

Registration in the place of competition (*Olympic Sports Centre*) on 26th March at 18:30-20:00
OR on the day of competition at 8.30-9.45.

NO other CHANGES than crossing out a participant will be made on the day of competition!

Competition rules:

- U16, +16 y. categories – WKF rules
- In all individual KATA categories, excluding U16 and +16y., both sportsmen perform Kata at the same time.
- U8 OPEN – sportsmen must know at least 1 Kata.
- U10 OPEN – sportsmen must know at least 2 Kata.
- U12 OPEN, U14 OPEN categories – sportsmen must know at least 3 Kata.
- Other U8, U10, U12, U14 KYU categories round-robin system. Sportsmen are allowed to perform only kata from the following list: Taikioku, Heian 1-5, Pinan 1-5, Geksdai 1-2, Ten no Kata, Saifa. Each sportsman must know at least 2 Kata.
- U10 -9kyu, U12 -9kyu, U14 -9kyu categories round-robin system. Sportsmen are allowed to perform only kata from the following list: Taikioku, Heian 1-5, Pinan 1-5, Geksdai 1-2, Ten no Kata, Saifa. Each sportsman must know at least 1 Kata.
- Duration of fights: 6-13 years - 1,5 minutes, weight allowance 0.5kg.
- U8, U10, U12, U14 Kumite categories – up to 6 pionts difference. Equipment – full, body protectors are optional.
- In categories U16, U18 full equipment according to WKF rules.
- SUMO: round-robin system (till 2 victories). Size of tatami – 3x3 m.
- FANTOM kumite: round-robin system, duration 20 seconds, number of judges – 3. Skin touch allowed. Criteria of evaluation: accuracy, speed and strenght, diversity of punches, kicks and combinations, sense of distance. Equipment: Red belt and mitts for AKA, blue belt and mitts for AO are madatory, leg protectors of the same color are allowed.
- One 3rd place in all categories.
- Protest consideration – 100 EUR.



All sportsmen are responsible for their health insurance and medical allowance to participate in the tournament.

Registration fee: 20 EUR per category

Team kata, kumite – 35 EUR per team

Competence: All questions that are not included in this restriction are answered according to organizing and referee's committees.

Awards:

Three best sportsmen in each category are awarded!

1st place winners are awarded with cups, medals and diplomas; in Junior Kumite categories winner will be awarded with 50 EUR money prize, and in Seniors Kumite category the winner will be awarded with 100 EUR money prize.

2nd and 3rd place winners are awarded with medals and diplomas.

Best 3 kata and kumite teams in each category are awarded with medals, cups and diplomas.

At the end of the day three best clubs in every discipline (according to number of 1st places won, if the number of won 1st places is equal, 2nd places are counted etc.) **will be awarded with cups!**

The best team according to overall standings in all 4 disciplines will be awarded with
RIGA CUP!
