REGULATION

GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

- To popularize Karate-Do as a sport.
- To promote the sport among young people.
- To establish and improve the friendly relations between the athletes, coaches and parents of the tournament.

ORGANIZER

Jelgava karate club "VITUS" in collaboration with the Latvian Karate Federation (LKF), with support from Jelgava Centre of Sports Service.

PLACE AND DATE

May 27, 2017, from 10.00 in Jelgava Sports hall (Matera street 44a, Jelgava, Latvia, LV-3001). Registration and payment of fees for participation to 9.00-9.45 at the event site. All participants need to have an karate identity document showing age and kyu.

JUDGES

An LKF panel of judges. We invite judges from other organizations. The judges will be paid.

The consideration of protest will be 100 EUR and to file a grievance you must have video footage.

WKF Rules with changes by the organizer.

PARTICIPATION IN COMPETITIONS

The competition is open to all athletes - boys and girls older than 5 years.

All participants must be dressed in a kimono (Karate Gi)!

Participants are responsible for their compliance with the health status for the participation in the tournament rules (if the participant has not reached the age of majority, the responsibility lies with the parents, guardians or trustees).

An athlete can participate in several categories in one discipline (their level and above). Allowable overweight: 500 grams

If an athlete does not meet the requirements for the chosen category specified in their application, they will be disqualified and will not be able to take further part in the competition. In this case, the participation fee will not be refunded! The coach will be responsible for the timely exit of the athlete from the mat.

The organizer reserves the right to change the category.

EUR 20 per category. No discounts for participation in more than one category.

Terms of KATA. The size of the arena is 8m x 8m. Contestants are allowed to perform any kata. Athletes perform kata at the same time (you can wear your own kyu or dan belt) on a "Olympic system with repechage fights" basis. Athletes under 7 years old may make one KATA; from 8 to 9 years old – competitors must perform a minimum of 2 different KATA; from 10 to 13 years - at least 3 different KATA. For athletes over 14 years old Kata competitions are held according to WKF rules.

Rules for KUMITE. The size of the arena is 8m x 8m. The duration of the fight for children up to 7 years - 1 minute, from 8 to 13 years – 1.5 minutes. The fight goes to the difference of 6 points. For 14 years old and older - the rules of WKF apply. Contestant outfit: gloves on hands and protection for shin and feet as per WKF regulations and a mouthguard are obligatory. A protective chest vest can be worn. Participants should bring their own equipment. The organizers will not provide equipment. Gloves, feet protection and belt color must be blue for AO and red for AKA. "Olympic system" with repechage fights.

AWARDS

1st, 2nd, 3rd places will be presented with cups and diplomas. In all categories there are one 3rd place.
